A RESOLUTION

1 **Suspending Rules 47 and 55, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, relating to**
2 **the carry-over of bills from the First Regular Session to the Fourth Special Session,**
3 **concerning Senate Bill No. 54.**

4 **BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 That under Rule 54, Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, the provisions of
6 Rule 47 of the Uniform Rules regarding the carry-over of bills and the provisions of Rule 55
7 of the Uniform Rules regarding the use of Mason's Manual of Legislative Procedure to cover
8 situations not directly addressed by the Uniform Rules are suspended in consideration of
9 Senate Bill No. 54 – An Act relating to crime and criminal law; relating to violation of
10 condition of release; relating to sex trafficking; relating to sentencing; relating to
11 imprisonment; relating to parole; relating to probation; relating to driving without a license;
12 and relating to the pretrial services program.
