## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA  
2017 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

This legislation would provide a funding mechanism to pay premiums to continue medical insurance coverage for the surviving spouse and dependent children of State of Alaska and participating municipality's peace officer or firefighter employees killed in the line of duty. The legislation requires the State of Alaska to pay the medical insurance premium for surviving spouse and dependent children of state peace officer or firefighter employees killed in the line of duty.

Municipalities may elect to pay the medical insurance premiums for surviving spouse and dependent children of the municipality's peace officer or firefighter employees killed in the line of duty. This legislation would specifically impact surviving spouse and dependent children whose only medical coverage was that provided by a deceased police officer or firefighter who was a permanent full time employee and covered under employer sponsored medical insurance at the time of their death.

The bill provides that the Department of Public Safety shall manage and administer the police officer and firefighter survivors' fund in cooperation with the Department of Administration. The costs associated with this would be minimal and absorbed in the cost of normal business for the Department.
