FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2018 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

This bill amends AS 17.38.200(a) dealing with marijuana establishment registrations to require persons renewing a marijuana establishment registration to submit their fingerprints to the Department of Public Safety (DPS) for a national criminal history record check every six years.

Passage of this legislation would increase the number of background checks DPS would conduct once every six years. The effects on the workload will be minimal and would result in a nominal increase in program receipts for the Division of Statewide Services' Criminal Records & Identification Bureau. Therefore, a zero fiscal note is being submitted.
