**Analysis**

The original bill would have divested the Workers' Compensation Board of its jurisdiction to adjudicate all or nearly all workers' compensation claims, transferring jurisdiction over these claims to the Office of Administrative Hearings (OAH), with substantial fiscal impacts.

The Senate Labor & Commerce Committee Substitute does not make this transfer. CS SB 112 will have no fiscal impact on OAH; therefore the agency submits a zero fiscal note.
