FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2018 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

SB 204 amends AS 28.10.181(d) to allow a licensed chiropractor to provide proof of disability so that a disabled veteran license plate may be issued. DMV currently accepts proof of disability from licensed physicians, physician assistants, or advanced practice registered nurses under AS 08.68.

The acceptance of proof from a chiropractor will not require any additional programming; therefore DMV is submitting a zero fiscal note.
