# Thirty-eighth Day

Pursuant to adjournment the Senate was called to order by President Kelly at 10:51 a.m.

The roll showed seventeen members present. Senator Wielechowski was excused from a call of the Senate. Senator Costello was absent. The seat from District E was vacant.

The prayer was offered by the Chaplain, Michelle Hale, Council Member of the Juneau Shambhala Center. Senator Hoffman moved and asked unanimous consent that the prayer be spread. Without objection, it was so ordered.

Representative Tuck moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the House be waived and all members be shown as present. Without objection, it was so ordered.

President Kelly appointed Representative Chenault and Senator Gardner to escort Senator Murkowski to the Joint Session.

The Senate Sergeant-at-Arms, Grace Ellsworth, announced the Honorable Lisa Murkowski's entrance to the House Chamber.

Senator Murkowski was escorted to the rostrum and welcomed by President Kelly.

The Honorable Lisa Murkowski delivered her address. This address appears in Senate and House Joint Journal Supplement No. 16.

Following her address, there was a question and answer period. Senator Murkowski received a standing ovation and was escorted from the chamber by Senator Gardner and Representative Chenault.

Senator Micciche moved and asked unanimous consent that the Joint Session stand in adjournment. Without objection, President Kelly adjourned the Joint Session at 12:02 p.m.
