CHAIR KEVIN MEYER called the Senate Rules Standing Committee meeting to order at 4:42 p.m. All members were present at the call to order.

HB 213-PUBLIC SCHOOL TRUST FUND

CHAIR MEYER announced consideration of HB 213. [SCS CSHB 213(FIN), version 30-LS0765\T, was before the committee.]

REPRESENTATIVE KELLY moved to adopt SCS CSHB 213(RLS), version 30-LS0765\I.

CHAIR MEYER objected for discussion purposes.

SENATOR BISHOP, Alaska State Legislature, Juneau, Alaska, said both these bills complement each other in supporting education.

PETE FELMAN, staff to Senator Bishop, Alaska State Legislature, Juneau, Alaska, provided a sectional analysis for SCS CSHB 213 (RLS), version 30-LS0765\I. He stated as follows:

Section 1, page 1, line 11 is legislative intent language that makes it clear that the intent is that any money raised by the education raffle will supplement - not supplant - any current funding.

Section 2 is on page 2, line 26, allows adding the Permanent Fund Education Raffle to the statutes, exempting it from the gambling statutes.

CHAIR MEYER interrupted to ask him for just a high-level summary since this bill had been heard before.

MR. FELMAN skipped to Section 7 that allows for the contributions to be categorized according to how much money is in the donations.

Section 8 creates the Education Endowment Fund that will be managed by the commissioner.

Section 8 also creates the Dividend Raffle Fund that has a cap of \$300 million and it allows donations to go in and then prizes to be paid out of that. Eighty-five percent of that money will stay in the Raffle Fund.

Section 9 has no changes.

REPRESENTATIVE KELLY moved to report SCS CSHB 213(RLS) from committee with individual recommendations. There were no objections and it was so ordered.

HB 280-EXTEND: BOARD OF MARITAL & FAMILY THERAPY

CHAIR MEYER announced consideration of HB 280. [HB 280, version 30-LS1162\D, was before the committee.]

REPRESENTATIVE KELLY moved to adopt SCS HB 280(RLS), version 30-LS1162\O, dated 4/18/18, as the working document.

SENATOR GIESSEL, sponsor of SB 108, Alaska State Legislature, Juneau, Alaska, explained that this bill inserts part of SB 108 on State Medical Board Licensing and Practice of Medicine into the original HB 280, which was the termination date for Board of Marital and Family Therapists. She talked with the House sponsor who agreed to the insertions and explained that SB 108 "got hung up" on other side, but there are two urgent elements that the State Medical Board needs out of the original Senate bill.

SENATOR GIESSEL explained that Section 1 of HB 280 is the original Board of Marital and Family Therapists board extension. Sections 2, 3, and 5-11 all authorize the executive secretary of the State Board of Medicine to approve clean medical licenses, meaning complete, no criminal background, and no disciplinary actions.

Section 4 does the second critical piece for the State Medical Board and gives doctors the authority to delegate particular routine medical duties to unlicensed personnel.

Section 12 is an immediate effective date for the Marital and Family Therapists and for the Board of Medicine to write regulations.

Section 13 is the effective date for the rest of the State Medical Board issues.

She said this will meet the critical need of the State Medical Board.

CHAIR MEYER, finding no questions, removed his objection and version O was adopted.

SENATOR GARDNER asked if an osteopath is a physician.

SENATOR GIESSEL answered that they are considered physicians.
