Senator Hoffman MOVED to ADOPT the Senate version of the bill, version D.

Co-Chair Foster OBJECTED.

A roll call vote was taken on the motion.

The MOTION to adopt version D FAILED (2/4).

Co-Chair Foster MOVED to ADOPT the House version of the bill, version R.A.

Co-Chair MacKinnon OBJECTED.

A roll call vote was taken on the motion.

IN FAVOR: Egan, Seaton, Foster

OPPOSED: Thompson, Hoffman, MacKinnon

The MOTION to adopt version R.A FAILED (3/3).

Co-Chair MacKinnon directed members' attention to the spreadsheet in their folders, and encouraged them to study it before the next meeting.
