A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 "An Act establishing May 31 of each year as Katie John Day; and providing for an
2 effective date."

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 * **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

5 **Sec. 44.12.063. Katie John Day.** Katie John Day is established on May 31 of
6 each year to honor Ahtna Athabascan elder Katie John for her mentoring and
7 advocacy in defense of Alaska Native customary and traditional hunting, fishing, and
8 gathering rights. Katie John Day may be observed by suitable observances and
9 exercises by civic groups and the public.

10 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
