FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2018 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

As this bill was written, it will require an additional option on the online PFD application. This option will allow specified Veterans to assign a portion, or all, of their PFD to be assigned to the Department of Natural Resources for the purchase of State land. This will require a total of 89 hours for programming at a rate of \$120.00 per hour. Assuming that this program strictly applies to Veterans, the option will only be provided to those who answer "Yes" to the question "Are you, or have you ever been an active member of the US armed forces?". Assuming that the method above is satisfactory, we don't anticipate a high level of increased public contact as it will reside in an area only seen by active or former military members.

Annual maintenance for this program will be 15 hours for updates, bug fixes, and to supply annual reports to DNR.
