FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2019 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

This legislation removes marriage as a defense in all circumstances except where the victim is mentally incapable and in the offender's care, and where there is consent but the conduct is illegal due to the nature of the relationship (i.e. probation officer/probationer, peace officer/person in custody, Juvenile Justice officer/person 18 or 19 and under the jurisdiction of the Division of Juvenile Justice).

The legislation also requires any person who is required to register as a sex offender in another state to register as a sex offender when they are physically present in Alaska.

The Department of Law does not anticipate a fiscal impact from this legislation.
