FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2019 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill increases the number of inmates to a level that exceeds the system's capacity requiring the department to reopen the currently-shuttered Palmer Correctional Center (PCC). The utilities in 2016 for PCC were \$830.0. Adjusted for inflation using the Bureau of Labor Statistics Consumer Price Index (CPI) utilities are projected to cost \$876.8 in FY2020.
