FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

HB 174 raises the minimum age to purchase, sell, exchange, or possess tobacco products, electronic smoking products, or products containing nicotine from 19 years of age to 21 years of age.

This legislation does not significantly change the business licensing program within the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing. The division does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.

The Business Licensing section of the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing is funded by General Fund/Program Receipts fund source 1005 GF/Prgm (DGF). Business licensing fees are set per AS 43.70, and revenue in excess of authorized budgeted expenses reverts to the State of Alaska general fund.
