FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

This legislation amends the authority of pretrial service officers allowing them to file charges, make warrantless arrests, or request the courts to issue a warrant for arrest for escape in the third degree (AS 11.56.320). Currently, pretrial service officers detain person(s) and wait for a local law enforcement agency to take appropriate action. This legislation will allow the pretrial service officer to take immediate action and eliminate the burden placed on law enforcement officers for these types of cases.

If passed, this legislation will have no financial impact, therefore, the department is submitting a zero fiscal note.
