FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

The Multistate Nurse Licensure Compact would allow registered and practical nurses in any of the two dozen participating states to practice in Alaska without having to go through what can be a time-consuming licensing process. This bill would not affect certified nurse aides, advanced practice registered nurses, or anyone else who wishes to practice under an Alaska-only nursing license. The bill makes it easier for a nurse to practice temporarily in Alaska, and it is optional for Alaska nurses to get a multistate license.

The bill does not have any immediate operational impact on the nurses employed by the department but when an organization such as Public Health Nursing or the Alaska Psychiatric Institute is recruiting experienced nurses, a compact would streamline hiring nurses from other compacting states.

This bill has no fiscal impact to the department.
