## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

## Analysis

The Judiciary Committee substitute for Senate Bill 35 makes numerous changes to the definitions of various criminal offenses, including sexual crimes. It revises certain defenses to provide that they are not available to those charged with sexual crimes, and it reclassifies certain sex crimes. The bill also expands the requirement for registering for sexual offenses with the Department of Public Safety to provide that those who have committed registerable sex offenses in another state must also register in this state.

Applying the revised and new laws with expanded definitions of sexual crimes may have the effect of having more cases filed with the court, and more court trials for sexual crimes. At this time, the court system anticipates that it can absorb the additional case filings and trials without a fiscal impact on the court system. The court system therefore submits this zero fiscal note.
