FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

Analysis

The proposed legislation repeals the Alaska Public Broadcasting Commission effective June 30, 2019, and transfers all commission assets to the Department of Administration. The Public Broadcasting TV component provides state grants to TV broadcast stations as approved by the Public Broadcasting Commission.
