FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

Analysis

SB 68 replaces a dental hygienist collaborative agreement with an advanced practice permit. Currently, a dental hygienist may perform certain dental hygiene procedures outside of a dental office if under a board-approved collaborative agreement with a currently-licensed dentist who has a dental practice in this state. SB 68 gives the dental hygienist more autonomy through the hygienist's ability to be an independent contractor and increases the hygienist's scope of practice. SB 68 authorizes reimbursement for services by an insurance provider through the Division of Insurance, and allows for coverage under the public assistance program through the Department of Health and Social Services.

The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing anticipates the following fiscal impact if the bill passes, but can absorb the expenses using existing authority:

Services: \$3.1 (printing, postage, and legal costs for regulations project to conform with statutory changes)

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065 so the total amount of revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs.
