FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

Analysis

This bill will remove The Department of Natural Resources' (DNR) authority/jurisdiction over all persons and property, public and private, necessary to carry out the purposes and intent of AS 41.06 – leaving the jurisdiction and authority solely with the Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission (AOGCC).

This legislation will not have a fiscal impact upon the Alaska Oil and Gas Conservation Commission.
