FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

This bill changes the statutes to include an additional fee for specialty license plates, not to exceed \$50. The Alaska State Council on the Arts (Council) shall determine the fee. The balance, in excess of costs for issuing the license plates, may be appropriated by the legislature to the Council.

This bill has an unknown fiscal impact on the Division of Motor Vehicles (DMV). It is unknown what fee the Council will set, or what the cost for production will be. DMV also does not know how many plates will be sold and therefore submits an indeterminate fiscal note.
