FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

SB173 will move the registration and licensing of Mobile Intensive Care Paramedics (MICP) from the State Medical Board, Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing, and place them under the Department of Health and Social Services (DHSS), Division of Emergency Services. This legislation will provide a career path for Emergency Medical Technicians (EMT) to become MICPs, as EMTs are currently licensed by DHSS.

The Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing does not anticipate fiscal impact from this legislation.

Professional licensing programs within the Division of Corporations, Business and Professional Licensing are funded by Receipt Supported Services, fund source 1156 Rcpt Svcs (DGF). Licensing fees for each occupation are set per AS 08.01.065 so the total amount of revenue collected approximately equals the occupation's actual regulatory costs.
