2020 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

Passage of this legislation will not have any additional fiscal impact on the division. The division receives appropriations to conduct the primary and general elections. These appropriations will be used to cover costs, if needed, of conducting a primary and/or general election by mail.

This legislation provides authorization for the division to promulgate emergency regulations, if needed, to implement by mail voting at the statewide level. The division anticipates needing the regulations in effect by 6/1/2020.
