Roll call showed 32 members present. Representatives Carpenter, Neuman, Rauscher, and Talerico had been excused from a call of the House today.

Representative Thompson moved and asked unanimous consent that Representatives Claman, Fields, Kreiss-Tomkins, and Spohnholz be excused from a call of the House today. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

The invocation was offered by the Chaplain, Representative Stutes. Representative Drummond moved and asked unanimous consent that the invocation be spread on the journal. There being no objection, it was so ordered.
