The amount necessary for payment of \$1,000 to each individual who is eligible to receive a 2020 permanent fund dividend is appropriated from the earnings reserve account (AS 37.13.145) to the dividend fund (AS 43.23.045(a)) for the fiscal year ending June 30, 2020, for economic stimulus payments for economic relief from the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19) outbreak to individuals who are eligible to receive a 2020 permanent fund dividend, and for administrative and associated costs, on or before June 30, 2020.
