page 12, line 30:

delete "If applicable federal, state, or municipal health mandates were not in effect at the time of the exposure, substantial compliance by the licensee with federal health guidelines or health mandates issued by a municipality in effect at the time of exposure precludes a finding of gross negligence under this subsection."

page 13, line 26:

delete "If applicable federal, state, or municipal health mandates were not in effect at the time of the exposure, substantial compliance by a person who engages in business, or by an employee of a person who engages in business when working in the business, with federal health guidelines or health mandates issued by a municipality in effect at the time of exposure precludes a finding of gross negligence under (c) of this section."
