1 Page 2, line 1, following "COVID-19;":

2 Insert "relating to a declaration of a disaster emergency;"

4 Page 14, following line 10:

5 Insert a new bill section to read:

6 "* Sec. 17. AS 26.23.020(c) is amended to read:

7 (c) If the governor finds that a disaster has occurred or that a disaster is
8 imminent or threatened, the governor shall, by proclamation, declare a condition of
9 disaster emergency. The disaster emergency remains in effect until the governor or
10 the legislature finds that the danger has passed or the disaster has been dealt with so
11 that the emergency no longer exists. The governor may terminate the disaster
12 emergency by proclamation or the legislature may terminate the disaster
13 emergency by a majority vote of the members in joint session or by a concurrent
14 resolution. A proclamation of disaster emergency may not remain in effect longer
15 than 30 days unless extended by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint
16 session or by a concurrent resolution. The proclamation must indicate the nature of
17 the disaster, the area threatened or affected, and the conditions that have brought it
18 about or that make possible the termination of the disaster emergency. A proclamation
19 to declare a condition of disaster emergency must also state whether the governor
20 proposes to expend state funds to respond to the disaster under (i) or (j) of this section.
21 Unless authorized by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint session
22 or by concurrent resolution, the governor may not declare a condition of disaster
23 emergency

1 **(1) while a declared condition of disaster emergency remains in**
2 **effect; and**

3 **(2) related to a condition of disaster emergency previously**
4 **declared by that governor."**
