1 Page 12, line 27, through page 13, line 2:

2 Delete "Substantial compliance by the licensee with applicable federal, state, or  
3 municipal public health mandates in effect at the time of the exposure precludes a finding of  
4 gross negligence under this subsection. If applicable federal, state, or municipal health  
5 mandates were not in effect at the time of the exposure, substantial compliance by the licensee  
6 with federal health guidelines or health mandates issued by a municipality in effect at the time  
7 of exposure precludes a finding of gross negligence under this subsection."

9 Page 13, lines 22 - 31:

10 Delete all material.

12 Reletter the following subsection accordingly.

14 Page 14, line 23:

15 Delete "February 15, 2021"

16 Insert "March 11, 2020, in a civil action filed on or after the effective date of this Act"

19 Delete "Except as provided in (b) of this section, this Act is"

20 Insert "Sections 1, 2(b) - (d), 3 - 10, 12, 13, and 16 - 20 of this Act are"
