14 Delete all material and insert:

15 "(2) "passenger vehicle" means a motor vehicle as defined in
16 AS 28.90.990 that is driven or moved on a highway or other public right-of-way
17 in the state, but does not include

18 (A) a commercial motor vehicle as that term is defined in
19 AS 28.90.990;

20 (B) emergency or fire equipment that is necessary to the
21 preservation of life or property;

22 (C) a farm vehicle that is controlled and operated by a
23 farmer, used to transport agricultural products, farm machinery, or farm
24 supplies to or from that farmer's farm, not used in the operations of a

1 common or contract motor carrier, and used within 150 miles of the
2 farmer's farm;

3 (D) a recreational vehicle;

4 (E) a taxicab;

5 (F) a rental truck; in this subparagraph, "rental truck"
6 means a motor vehicle with a gross vehicle weight rating greater than
7 8,500 pounds that is designed, used, or maintained primarily for the
8 transportation of personal property;

9 (G) a vehicle provided by an automobile dealer to a
10 customer as replacement transportation during warranty, recall, or
11 service contract repairs if the dealer does not receive compensation from
12 the customer; or

13 (H) a motorcycle or a motor-driven cycle as those terms are
14 defined in AS 28.90.990;"

16 Page 3, line 21:

17 Delete all material and insert:

18 "(4) "recreational vehicle" means

19 (A) a motor vehicle or trailer for recreational dwelling
20 purposes;

21 (B) a motor home or other vehicle with a motor home body
22 style;

23 (C) a one-piece camper vehicle; and

24 (D) any other self-propelled vehicle with living quarters;"

26 Page 4, following line 4:

27 Insert a new bill section to read:

28 **"* Sec. 6.** AS 43.52.010, 43.52.020, 43.52.030, 43.52.040, 43.52.050, 43.52.060, 43.52.070,
29 43.52.080, 43.52.090, and 43.52.099 are repealed."
