8 (e) The institutions receiving funding under (d) of this section shall provide an  
9 expenditure and performance report to the department by November 1 of each year  
10 that includes

11 (1) the percentage of former participants in the program who have jobs  
12 one year after leaving the program;

13 (2) the median wage of former participants at both six months and  
14 [SEVEN TO] 12 months after leaving the program;

15 (3) the percentage of former participants who were employed after  
16 leaving the program who received training under the program that was related or  
17 somewhat related to the former participants' jobs at both six months and [SEVEN  
18 TO] 12 months after leaving the program;

19 (4) a description of each vocational education course funded through  
20 the allocation set out in (d) of this section that permits high school students to earn  
21 dual credit upon course completion, and the number of high school students who  
22 earned dual credit in the past year;

23 (5) a copy of any articulation agreement established under (g) of this

1 section that either was in effect for the preceding year or is in process for the next year  
2 of funding, and the number of high school students who earned dual credit under each  
3 articulation agreement; [AND]

4 (6) the performance and financial information needed to verify the  
5 performance of the program as specified by the department by regulation, including  
6 the percentage of a funding allocation under (d) of this section that the institution  
7 expended on supplies and other general operational costs not directly related to  
8 the education of a participant; and

9 (7) for each participant,

10 (A) age, in years;

11 (B) the amount of a funding allocation under (d) of this  
12 section received from the program as a grant or other financial aid;

13 (C) the number of pay periods for which an employee  
14 contribution to unemployment insurance was made."
