3 **\*\* Sec. 4.** AS 38.20.040 is amended to read:

4 **Sec. 38.20.040. Use of coordinate system.** The plane coordinates of a point on  
5 the earth's surface, to be used in expressing the position or location of the point in the  
6 appropriate zone of this system, consist of two distances, expressed in U.S. Survey  
7 feet and decimals of a U.S. Survey foot when using the Alaska Coordinate System of  
8 1927 and expressed in meters and decimals of a meter when using the Alaska  
9 Coordinate System of 1983 and expressed in meters and decimals of a meter or  
10 International feet and decimals of an International foot when using the Alaska  
11 Coordinate System of 2022. One of these distances, known as the "x-coordinate,"  
12 gives the position in an east-and-west direction; the other known as the "y-coordinate"  
13 gives the position in a north-and-south direction. These coordinates shall be made to  
14 depend on [UPON] and conform to the coordinates of the National Spatial Reference  
15 System [NORTH AMERICAN HORIZONTAL GEODETIC CONTROL  
16 NETWORK] as determined by the National Geodetic Survey, National Ocean  
17 Service."
