14 MUNICIPALITY CONTAINS MORE THAN ONE HOUSE DISTRICT, ONLY
15 ONE COMMISSION OFFICE SHALL BE ESTABLISHED IN THAT
16 MUNICIPALITY. THE REGIONAL OFFICE SHALL MAKE ALL FORMS AND
17 PERTINENT MATERIAL AVAILABLE TO CANDIDATES. ALL REPORTS
18 SHALL BE FILED BY CANDIDATES, GROUPS, AND INDIVIDUALS
19 DIRECTLY WITH THE COMMISSION'S CENTRAL DISTRICT OFFICE. THE
20 COMMISSION SHALL ENSURE THAT COPIES OF ALL REPORTS BY
21 STATEWIDE AND LEGISLATIVE CANDIDATES IN EACH SENATE DISTRICT
22 ARE FORWARDED PROMPTLY TO THAT DISTRICT OR REGIONAL
23 OFFICE]."
