A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

"An Act relating to driver's license renewal."

BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

*** Section 1.** AS 28.15.101(a) is amended to read:

(a) Except as otherwise provided in this chapter, a driver's license expires on the licensee's birthday in the eighth year following issuance of the license. A license may be renewed [WITHIN ONE YEAR OF ITS EXPIRATION] upon proper application, payment of the required fee, and, except when a license is renewed under (c) of this section, successful completion of a test of the licensee's eyesight

(1) within one year of expiration of the license; or

(2) within two years of expiration of the license if the licensee is

(A) a member of the military who is deployed, stationed, or under orders to be deployed abroad; or

(B) a spouse or dependent of a member of the military who

(i) is residing abroad with a member who is deployed or stationed abroad; or

1 (ii) will be residing abroad with a member who is
2 under orders to be deployed abroad.

3 * **Sec. 2.** AS 28.15.101 is amended by adding a new subsection to read:

(e) In this section, "military" means the armed forces of the United States or the Alaska National Guard.
