**A BILL**

**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 **"An Act relating to allocations for the special education service agency; extending the**  
2 **special education service agency; and providing for an effective date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 **\* Section 1.** AS 14.30.650 is amended to read:

5 **Sec. 14.30.650. Funding.** Each fiscal year, the department shall allocate to the  
6 agency not less than **\$23.13** [\$18.65] times the number of students in the state in  
7 average daily membership in the preceding fiscal year as determined under  
8 AS 14.17.600. Money to carry out the provisions of this section may be appropriated  
9 annually by the legislature. If amounts are insufficient to meet the allocation  
10 authorized under this section for a fiscal year, the allocation shall be reduced pro rata.

11 **\* Sec. 2.** AS 44.66.010(a)(6) is amended to read:

12 (6) special education service agency (AS 14.30.600) - **June 30, 2029**

14 **\* Sec. 3.** The uncodified law of the State of Alaska is amended by adding a new section to

2 RETROACTIVITY. Section 2 of this Act is retroactive to June 30, 2021.

3 \* **Sec. 4.** Section 1 of this Act takes effect July 1, 2021.

4 \* **Sec. 5.** Except as provided in sec. 4 of this Act, this Act takes effect immediately under
