A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act extending an exemption from regulation as a public utility for plants and**
2 **facilities generating electricity entirely from renewable energy resources; and providing**
3 **for an effective date."**

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** AS 42.05.711(r) is amended to read:

6 (r) A plant or facility that generates electricity entirely from renewable energy
7 resources is exempt from regulation under this chapter, **other than applicable**
8 **regulation under AS 42.05.760 - 42.05.790**, if

9 (1) the plant or facility

10 (A) is first placed into commercial operation on or after
11 August 31, 2010, and before July 1, **2028** [2021]; and

12 (B) does not generate more than 65 megawatts of electricity;

13 (2) the electricity generated by the plant or facility is sold only to one
14 or more electric utilities that are regulated by the commission; and

1 (3) the person that constructs, owns, acquires, or operates the plant or
2 facility has not received from the state

3 (A) a grant that was used to generate the electricity from the
4 renewable energy resources; or

5 (B) a tax credit related to the generation of electricity from the
6 renewable energy resources.

7 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect July 1, 2021.
