**A BILL****FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**1 **"An Act relating to opioid overdose drugs; and providing for an effective date."**2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**3 \* **Section 1.** AS 17.20.085(c) is amended to read:4 (c) The chief medical officer of the department may issue a standing order,  
5 including a statewide standing order, for the prescription of an opioid overdose drug.  
6 [A STANDING ORDER ISSUED UNDER THIS SUBSECTION MUST EXPIRE  
7 ON OR BEFORE JUNE 30, 2021.]8 \* **Sec. 2.** AS 17.20.085(d) is amended to read:9 (d) Annually, on or before October 1, the department shall complete a report  
10 describing activities and expenditures related to Substance Abuse and Mental Health  
11 Services Administration grants and **opioid overdose drug distribution** [THE  
12 OPIOID EPIDEMIC] and shall submit the report to the senate secretary and chief  
13 clerk of the house of representatives and notify the legislature that the report is  
14 available.15 \* **Sec. 3.** Section 2, ch. 1, SLA 2017, is repealed.
