## FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA  
2021 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

This bill encourages collaboration between the Departments of Education and Early Development (DEED) and Labor and Workforce Development, and the University of Alaska Board of Regents, to provide financial and technical support to school districts and postsecondary institutions towards the creation or expansion of school to apprenticeship programs or concurrent secondary education and apprenticeship programs for students in Alaska. DEED currently works in collaboration with school districts to increase career, technical, and culturally relevant education to meet student and workforce needs.

Additionally, the bill establishes a tax credit for businesses who hire, employ, and train registered apprenticeship participants.

The bill is not expected to have a fiscal impact on DEED as collaboration efforts are already occurring.
