FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION**Analysis**

This bill amend the definition of “domestic violence” to include harassment in the second degree where a person publishes or distributes electronic or printed photographs, pictures, or films that show the genitals, anus, or female breast of another person or show that person engaged in a sexual act. AS 11.61.120(a)(6).

The definition of domestic violence is used in a number of criminal offenses such as “interfering with a report of a crime of domestic violence” under AS 11.56.745, when determining whether an offense is subject to mandatory arrest, and in obtaining a domestic violence protective order.

While this amendment may impact a number of areas in the criminal code the department does not anticipate a fiscal impact from those changes.
