FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

2022 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

SB 9 modifies the exemption from the Alaska business licensing requirement for businesses that sell only liquor to reflect the updated statutory reference. If the business sells anything in addition to liquor, they would be required to obtain an Alaska business license. There is no anticipated fiscal impact to the Division of Corporations, Business, and Professional Licensing (CBPL). <i>Business licensing at CBPL is funded by General Fund/Program Receipts fund source 1005 GF/Prgm (DGF). Business licensing fees are set per AS 43.70, and revenue in excess of authorized budgeted expenses reverts to the State of Alaska general fund.</i>
