Pursuant to adjournment the House was called to order by Speaker Stutes at 6:50 p.m.

The Speaker stated that, without objection, the House would stand at ease to allow members of the Senate to enter the House Chamber; and so, the House stood at ease at 6:50 p.m.

JOINT SESSION IN THE HOUSE

In accordance with Uniform Rule 51, Speaker Stutes turned the gavel over to President Micciche who called the joint session to order at 7:00 p.m.

The purpose of the joint session was to hear the State of the State address by the Honorable Mike Dunleavy, Governor of Alaska.

Senator Hughes moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the Senate be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

Representative Tuck moved and asked unanimous consent that the roll call of the House be waived and all members be shown as present. There being no objection, it was so ordered.

President Micciche appointed Representative Johnson and Senator Myers to escort the Governor to the joint session.

The Senate Sergeant-at-Arms announced the Governor's entrance into the House Chamber.

Governor Dunleavy was escorted to the rostrum and welcomed by President Micciche.

Governor Dunleavy delivered his address, and it is published in Senate and House Joint Journal Supplement No. 9.

The Governor received a standing ovation.

Senator Hughes moved and asked unanimous consent that the joint session adjourn. There being no objection, President Micciche adjourned the joint session at 7:57 p.m.

The Speaker ordered the House at ease to allow members of the Senate to leave the Chamber.
