**Consideration of the Calendar****Second Reading of Senate Bills****SB 3006**

SENATE BILL NO. 3006 "An Act relating to utilization review requirements; making temporary changes to state law in response to the novel coronavirus disease (COVID-19); relating to telemedicine and telehealth; relating to background checks; and providing for an effective date" was read the second time.

Senator Costello, Chair, moved and asked unanimous consent for the adoption of the Labor and Commerce Committee Substitute offered on page 1420. Senator Begich objected, then withdrew his objection. There being no further objection, CS FOR SENATE BILL NO. 3006(L&C) "An Act relating to utilization review requirements; making temporary changes to state law in response to the novel coronavirus disease; relating to telemedicine and telehealth; relating to background checks; and providing for an effective date" was adopted.
