9 teacher certificate issued under this subsection is valid for the life of the retired teacher
10 and qualifies the holder as a substitute teacher in the state. A teacher certificated
11 under this subsection may teach as a long-term substitute teacher for not more
12 than 165 consecutive days of a school term. In this subsection, "long-term
13 substitute teacher" means a teacher who is employed in the state to substitute
14 teach for more than 20 consecutive days of a school term."
