10 "* **Sec. 4.** Rule 37(a), Uniform Rules of the Alaska State Legislature, is amended to read:

11 (a) Any member, [GROUP OF MEMBERS,] standing, special, or joint
12 committee may introduce a bill, subject to the provisions of these Uniform Rules. **In**
13 **accordance with AS 24.08.060(a), a committee chair may introduce a committee**
14 **bill or resolution if the request to introduce a committee bill or resolution is**
15 **signed by a majority of the active members of the committee.** A bill must be
16 introduced, in proper form as approved by the enrolling secretary of the legislature,
17 with the original and three copies delivered to the chief clerk or secretary. The bill is
18 then assigned a number which it retains through subsequent changes and substitutions.
19 The bill is considered formally introduced when the clerk or secretary reads the
20 heading and title aloud in open session (first reading). Bills may be introduced through
21 the Rules Committees by the governor and the permanent interim committees pursuant
22 to provisions of law."
