A BILL**FOR AN ACT ENTITLED**

1 "An Act relating to an amendment to the articles of incorporation of a corporation
 2 organized under the Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act; and providing for an
 3 effective date."

4 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

5 * **Section 1.** AS 10.06.504(d) is amended to read:

6 (d) The requirement of an affirmative vote of at least two-thirds of the shares
 7 entitled to vote for the adoption of an amendment to the articles of incorporation as
 8 provided in former AS 10.05.276 shall remain in force for corporations existing before
 9 July 1, 1989. **This subsection does not apply to a corporation organized under 43**
 10 **U.S.C. 1601 et seq. (Alaska Native Claims Settlement Act).**

11 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
