A BILL

FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to the Local Boundary Commission; and providing for an effective**
2 **date."**

3 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

4 *** Section 1.** AS 44.33.810 is amended to read:

5 **Sec. 44.33.810. Local Boundary Commission.** There is in the Department of
6 Commerce, Community, and Economic Development a Local Boundary Commission.
7 The Local Boundary Commission consists of five members appointed by the governor
8 for overlapping five-year terms. One member shall be appointed from each of the four
9 judicial districts described in AS 22.10.010 and one member shall be appointed from
10 the unorganized borough. The members from each judicial district must
11 maintain a principal place of abode and be registered to vote in a precinct in that
12 district. The member from the unorganized borough must maintain a principal
13 place of abode and be registered to vote in a precinct in the unorganized
14 borough. The commission shall select a chair from among its members [STATE

1 AT LARGE. THE MEMBER APPOINTED FROM THE STATE AT LARGE IS
2 THE CHAIR OF THE COMMISSION].

3 * **Sec. 2.** This Act takes effect January 31, 2025.
