FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act establishing 4-H Day."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 44.12 is amended by adding a new section to read:

4 **Sec. 44.12.106. 4-H Day.** The first Wednesday of October of each year is
5 established as 4-H Day, in recognition of the contributions of 4-H programs to the
6 positive development of youth in the state. 4-H Day may be observed by suitable
7 observances and exercises by civic groups and the public.
