FOR AN ACT ENTITLED

1 **"An Act relating to the office of victims' rights; and providing for an effective date."**

2 **BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:**

3 * **Section 1.** AS 24.65.060 is amended to read:

4 **Sec. 24.65.060. Compensation.** The victims' advocate is entitled to receive an
5 annual salary of Range 26 on the salary schedule set out in AS 39.27.011(a) **and (I)**
6 **[FOR JUNEAU].**

7 * **Sec. 2.** AS 24.65.070(c) is amended to read:

8 (c) The victims' advocate and the staff appointed by the victims' advocate are
9 in the exempt service under AS 39.25.110 and are not subject to the employment
10 policies under AS 24.10 or AS 24.20. **Staff appointed by the victims' advocate shall**

11 **(1) be compensated under the state salary schedule set out in**
12 **AS 39.27.011(a); or**

13 **(2) if the position requires admission to the practice of law in this**
14 **state as a condition of employment, be compensated under the state salary**
15 **schedule set out in AS 39.27.011(a) and (I).**

1 * **Sec. 3.** This Act takes effect immediately under AS 01.10.070(c).
