Disapproving Executive Order No. 126.

BE IT RESOLVED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF ALASKA:

WHEREAS the governor, under authority of art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State of Alaska, has proposed in Executive Order No. 126 to transfer the functions of the Wood-Tikchik State Park Management Council to the Department of Natural Resources and to eliminate the Wood-Tikchik State Park Management Council; and

WHEREAS art. III, sec. 23, Constitution of the State of Alaska, provides that unless disapproved within 60 days of a regular session by resolution concurred in by a majority of the members of the legislature in joint session, an executive order becomes effective at a date designated by the governor;

BE IT RESOLVED by the Alaska State Legislature that Executive Order No. 126 is disapproved.
