FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

The bill amends Division of Motor Vehicle (DMV) statutes to add a definition for electric-assisted bicycles. The bill establishes that electric-assisted bicycles are not considered motor vehicles, which precludes them from registration under title 28. The bill also separates an electric-assisted bicycle from a motor-driven cycle, which includes motorcycles, motor scooters, and motorized bicycles.

Historically, DMV has not registered these bicycles and this bill would clarify that DMV would not register electric-assisted bicycles. There is no financial or operational impact to the DMV and therefore, DMV submits a zero-fiscal note.
