FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA  
2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This bill advances the People's First Initiative by making substantive and conforming amendments to statutes relating to human and sex trafficking and sex offenses. This bill will further strengthen Alaska’s criminal justice system to protect victims, hold offenders accountable, and make Alaska safer.

This bill amends Alaska Statute (AS) 11.41, person crime statutes, to add a new sex trafficking. It also amends AS 11.66 to add new prostitution offenses.

The Department of Public Safety (DPS) Division of Alaska State Troopers (AST) Alaska Bureau of Investigation (ABI) is responsible for conducting investigations into crimes involving sex trafficking and human trafficking in its areas of responsibility. The DPS does not anticipate a significant fiscal impact at this time and is submitting a zero fiscal.
