FISCAL NOTE ANALYSIS

STATE OF ALASKA
2023 LEGISLATIVE SESSION

Analysis

This legislation amends AS 15.07.130(a) relating to voter registration list maintenance to require the Division of Elections to send a notice requesting address confirmation or correction to each voter who, according to information received by the division, is not domiciled in the state. The bill also adds new subsections that require the adoption of regulations that pertain to the review and updates of the master register, require the director to adopt a best practice voter registration system and develop a written maintenance schedule and guideline manual for the system, and provide a report on the system to the legislature. Many of the provisions of this bill are already in use in the division.

Passage of this bill would have no fiscal impact to the division. Therefore, a zero fiscal note is being submitted.
